

**CITY OF WEST ALLIS
RESOLUTION R-2026-5245**

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO ENTER INTO
REVISED STATE/MUNICIPAL AGREEMENTS WITH THE WISCONSIN
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF
CONNECTING HIGHWAYS 59 & 181**

WHEREAS, initial project agreements were signed in 2023 prior to initial scoping of the four connecting highway projects and based off rough lane mile estimates (see R-2023-0604); and,

WHEREAS, final scoping has been completed and the estimates have been refined to include items like sidewalk, lighting, streetscaping, etc., which increases design costs; and,

WHEREAS, the projects are currently scheduled for construction in 2029 through 2032, contingent on state budget approvals;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the City Engineer is authorized and directed to revise the State/Municipal Agreements with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for the Projects (State IDs 2165-05-00, 2230-05-02, 2230-05-03, and 2230-05-04), copies of which are attached.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total eligible estimated design project cost for these four projects is \$4,813,000, of which \$3,609,750 is the Federal share and the remaining \$1,146,750 is the local municipal share; it is understood that the City of West Allis will pay to the State all costs incurred by the State in connection with this project which exceed the Federal financing commitments or are ineligible for Federal financing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total eligible estimated construction project cost is \$28.3 million, of which \$27.6 million is anticipated to be the Federal share and the remaining \$775,330 is anticipated to be the local municipal share.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that prior to or during construction, the city will relay sanitary sewer and watermain, which will be funded by utility funding and is estimated to cost \$5.1 million.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds for this work are budgeted and available in the Bond Funds, Capital Project cash reserves (future reimbursement from special assessments), Sanitary Sewer Fund, Stormwater Management Fund, Water Utility Fund, Green Infrastructure, and the services will be charged to Account Number 350-6008-531.31-01.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer forward a certified copy of this Resolution, together with the executed State/Municipal Agreement, to the office of the WisDOT and take whatever further action is required to initiate and effect the street improvement design.

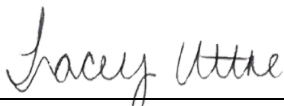

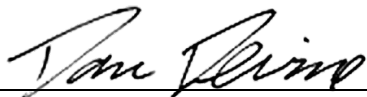
