Upon deliberation and consideration of the complaint presented at the License and Health Committee meeting held on June 16, 2015, the Committee finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. That Colleen Doolan was properly served a copy of the summons and complaint;
- 2. That Colleen Doolan admitted to the allegations that were stated in the complaint and, thus, the allegations in the complaint are considered to be true;
- 3. That the conduct of Colleen Doolan described in the complaint substantially relates to the tavern-related license contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(b);
- 4. That in particular, Colleen Doolan's 16 traffic convictions, including a conviction for operating while intoxicated, and pending case for operating while revoked is contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(b).

CONCLUSION OF LAW:

1. That the conduct of Colleen Doolan substantially relates to the alcohol beverage licensed activity contrary to Wis. Stat. § 125.04(5)(b); and that the foregoing constitutes a sufficient basis to suspend Colleen Doolan's operator's license for 21 days, beginning at 6:00 a.m. on July 1, 2015 and ending at 11:59 p.m. on July 21, 2015.

RECOMMENDATION:

 Therefore, the License and Health Committee recommends to the Common Council of the City of West Allis that Colleen Doolan's operator's license be suspended for 21 days, beginning at 6:00 a.m. on July 1, 2015 and ending at 11:59 p.m. on July 21, 2015.
