Mayor Devine & Mark,

When the attached ordinance is amended for the new period, I am requesting to add Special Voting Deputy to the list. It has been a volunteer position in the City, but after reviewing survey information from similar municipalities, it appears West Allis is the only one that requires this position to be volunteer, s. 7.03, Wis Stats. State Law has changed requiring more from this position, and I'm in the process of evaluating and implementing the expansion of absentee voting to other Residential Care Facilities other than just nursing homes as a result of Act 159. I am proposing \$10.00/hr for the position which is what the temporary election workers are paid, resulting in an approx. increase of \$1,000 annually to the budget (would be less in an odd year and more in the even years & dependent on how this new law impacts this absentee voting process in the City).
