

NARRATIVE

INITIAL CALL

On Friday 2-7-14 at approximately 0205 hrs, I, Officer Manthe, was working as patrol squad 310 for the City of West Allis when I responded to Captain Nick's Tavern, 1503 S 81 St in the City of West Allis for a female that had been struck

by a vehicle. Dispatch informed the vehicle was described as a White car with military plates and that it left the scene Eastbound. Dispatch further advised the WI military reg CHIFON did not list to a vehicle and had an associated address of 7724 W National Ave to a Wendell R Smith. Officers responded to the 7724 W National Ave location as well as the scene of the incident, 1503 S 81 St.

STATEMENT OF VICTIM- CORI M RICHARDSON

I arrived at the 1503 S 81 St location and observed a female standing in front of the tavern, later identified by WI driver license as Cori M Richardson, F/W DOB: 4-9-85. Upon initial contact, I could see Richardson appeared to be in distress as she was crying and slumped over. I could also see what appeared to be fresh snow on the right pant leg of Richardson. Richardson immediately said she was dragged and hit by a car, stating it was a White car with plates of CHIFON.

Richardson stated she had been dragged by a vehicle and then struck by the same vehicle as it fled the scene. Richardson advised she had arrived at the tavern (Captain Nick's) approximately on hour prior to this incident occurring and that two black females came into the tavern a short time later. Richardson said there was no confrontation inside the tavern and that she had never seen either female prior to this evening.

At the time of bar close, the bartender informed all patrons that they had five minutes to finish their drinks and leave the tavern. Richardson said the two Black female customers started to become argumentative because they believed they were being told to leave because they were black. Richardson said she still had not had any verbal contact with the two patrons and that they left the tavern without incident.

Richardson left the tavern and was standing by the front door of the tavern when she noticed the two females sitting in a white car in front of the tavern. Richardson said that the passenger of the vehicle rolled her window down and said, "What are you looking at?" Richardson approached the vehicle and told the occupants to "just leave" because she did not want any problems. The passenger of the vehicle started yelling at Richardson and reached out and grabbed her by the hair. Richardson heard the passenger tell the driver, "Go, go, go" and the driver of the vehicle began accelerating. Richardson said she lost her footing and was dragged by the vehicle as the passenger of the vehicle was holding on to her hair.

I asked Richardson how far she thought she was dragged and how fast she estimated the vehicle was traveling and she stated she did not know because she everything happened so fast. Richardson did not know how she broke free of being dragged by the vehicle but speculated that the passenger of the vehicle must have let go of her hair.

Richardson said she was laying in the roadway and had started to get up when the suspect vehicle came back around and struck her in the leg before driving off. Richardson said this was done intentionally and that she thought she was going to be run over by the vehicle. I asked Richardson how fast she estimated the vehicle was traveling at the time it struck her and she stated she was no sure but that the vehicle had not traveled far from the point it turned around.

I asked Richardson if she would be able to identify the females that were in the vehicle at the time of this incident and she stated that she would be able to identify both offenders.

INJURY TO VICTIM

Richardson said she received pain to her head in the area where he hair was pulled as she was dragged by the vehicle. Richardson also advised she had swelling to the back of her head from her head hitting the ground when she was released from being dragged. I did not observe any visible injuries to Richardson's head but felt swelling on the back of her head (high right side of the back of her head.)

Richardson stated she had some soreness to her leg but did not have any visible injury. She advised her body generally felt sore from being dragged and struck by the vehicle.

LACK OF CONSENT

Richardson did not consent to being grabbed by the passenger of the vehicle and dragged by her hair while the vehicle was moving. She further advised she did not consent to being struck by the vehicle and stated this incident caused her pain, injury, and caused her to fear for her life.

MEDICAL ATTENTION

Due to the severity of this incident and Richardson complaining of injury to her head, I requested an ambulance respond to 1503 S 81 St for medical treatment to the victim. Richardson was treated by EMS staff in the ambulance and refused transport to a hospital for further evaluation.

While checking for the offenders and vehicle involved in this incident, Officer Schneider located a White Dodge Avenger with WI reg CHIFON attached behind 7724 W National Ave. The driver of the vehicle was later identified as Christene D Smith, F/B DOB: 7-15-61, and the passenger of the vehicle was identified as Lakiesha J Bowie, F/B DOB: 1-10-81. (See Officer Schneider's Supplemental Report)

CONTACT WITH OFFENDER- LAKIESHA J BOWIE

Sgt Kempinski spoke with Lakiesha J Bowie while on scene at the 7724 W National Ave address. (See Sgt Kempinski's Supplemental Report)

ARREST DECISION

Based on video surveillance footage observed by Officer Binter and witness statements that Bowie and Smith dragged the victim, Richardson, from a vehicle and that Richardson was then struck intentionally by the vehicle, Bowie and Smith were both arrested for 1st Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety. Officer Schneider's investigation also revealed Smith was operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol. Smith was also arrested for Operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol causing injury. Because DOT records show this is Smith's second OWI arrest, this is a felony arrest.

VEHICLE DISPOSITION

N and S Towing responded to the 7724 W National Ave address and removed the vehicle as it was used in the commission of a felony as well as being involved in an alcohol related arrest.

While in detective interview room A at the West Allis PD, I attempted to interview Lakiesha J Bowie regarding this incident. Bowie was read her constitutional rights and advised she would not answer questions regarding this incident because she was lied to by police and said if she was being read her rights she was already going to jail. I advised Bowie police did not lie to her and that she was involved in an incident that was currently under investigation and she was being read her rights because I needed to speak with her regarding her involvement in this incident.

Lakiesha J Bowie was arrested for one count Recklessly Endangering Safety (1st Degree). She was processed, photographed, and fingerprinted and held for transport to the Milwaukee County Jail.

Christene D Smith was arrested for two counts Recklessly Endangering Safety (1st Degree) relating to her driving while Richardson was being dragged and then circling back to strike Richardson with the vehicle. Smith was also arrested for one count OWI 2nd Offense causing injury (Felony). She was processed, photographed, and fingerprinted and held for transport to the Milwaukee County Jail.

PHOTO ARRAY

I created a photo array for the driver, Christene D Smith (Line #14-000057) and the passenger Lakiesha J Bowie (14-000054). This photo array was provided to Officer R Stuettgen who had no knowledge of this case. Officer Stuettgen presented the photo arrays to the victim, Richardson, on 2-8-14. He advised the fifth photo (#50) was identified as the passenger in the vehicle. This number corresponds with the photo of Lakiesha J Bowie. Richardson was unable to identify the driver of the vehicle through the photo array process.

Officer Stuettgen returned the photo arrays and I placed them on property at the West Allis PD.

CASE DISPOSITION

On 2-7-14 at approximately 0205 hrs, officers responded to 1503 S 81 St (Captain Nick's Tavern) for a pedestrian struck by a vehicle. Cori M Richardson, F/W DOB: 4-9-85, stated she was standing outside the tavern when two Black females who were parked in front of the tavern started yelling at her. The passenger of the vehicle, identified by Rapid fingerprint ID as Lakiesha J Bowie, F/B DOB: 1-10-81, grabbed Richardson by the hair and told the driver of the vehicle to go, causing Richardson to be dragged approximately ten feet before being released. The driver of the vehicle was later identified as Christene D Smith F/B DOB: 7-15-61. Richardson hit her head on the ground when she was released and suffered swelling to the back of her head as a result of this incident. Richardson also complained that her head hurt from having her hair pulled by Bowie. Richardson stated the striking vehicle was a White car with WI Military reg CHIFON displayed. The vehicle, White 2008 Dodge Avenger with WI Military reg CHIFON displayed, was located at 7724 W National Ave with the two occupants. Bowie was arrested for Recklessly Endangering Safety (1St Degree) at 0245 hrs on 2-7-14 and transported to the West Allis Police Department. Smith was arrested for 2 counts 1st Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety and OWI 2nd Offense causing injury. Both subjects were transported to the Milwaukee County Jail. This case will be reviewed at the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on 2-8-14 at 0830 hrs.
