RESOLUTION R-2026-5222**

**RESOLUTION TO RENEW AGREEMENT WITH 120WATER TO PROVIDE LEAD
SERVICE LINE PLATFORM AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR \$50,666**

WHEREAS, the City of West Allis Water Division is required to comply with the United States Environmental Protection Agency’s revised Lead and Copper Rule (LCR) and upcoming Lead and Copper Rule Improvements (LCRI), which impose significant requirements for lead service line inventory, sampling, communication, and reporting; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of West Allis previously approved a 1-year agreement with 120Water on July 15, 2025; and

WHEREAS, 120Water submitted a proposal dated June 25, 2026, outlining an annual service agreement totaling \$50,666, which includes access to their PWS Platform and Enhanced Managed Services Package, providing the necessary software and technical support to meet regulatory compliance.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the Water Division is authorized to enter into an agreement with 120Water and to accept the attached proposal for services in the amount of \$50,666 for a one-year term, effective upon execution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funding for these services will be charged to Account Number 501-2901-537.32-01.
