The arrow turned green, the engine proceeded to turn and the passenger side mirror touched the driver's side mirror of a semi that was just to the north of it. The semi was heading WB on Greenfield Avenue in the south most lane. There was no damage to Engine 3. It was unknown if there was damage to the semi, he never stopped.
