2. 2017-0439 Additional discussion regarding continuation of grandfathered residency program.

Ms. Grill mentioned the discussion on this topic at the Committee's July 17 meeting, and noted the City Attorney's opinion on the issue; i.e., not paying the resident pay. Health Commissioner Nusslock and Public Health Nurse Opperman were present and offered comments. After further discussion, the Committee generally agreed that the resident payment to employees should have been stopped in 2014 when the residency policy was repealed. The following motion was made:

Ald. Roadt moved that the current policy in place should be followed, seconded by Ald. Weigel. The motion passed 4 - 1, with Ald. May voting no.

3. <u>2017-0446</u> Employee Benefit Committee update, and discussion relating to Benefit Plan Design ("BPD") language and benefits.

Ms. Grill mentioned the discussion on this topic at the Committee's July 17 meeting and that Anthem is removing exclusions on gender reassignment coverage. This is a policy decision as to what benefit level the Committee wants in place: full or partial coverage or exclude it totally. After additional discussion, the Committee consensus was to accept the Anthem language/policy which removes the exclusion on this coverage and pay for the procedure. The following motion was made:

Ald. Weigel moved to accept Anthem wording as it stands. The motion was seconded by Ald. May, and it passed unanimously.
