

West Allis Community Communications Corporation (WACCC)
Date: 7/29/04

During the Second Quarter the WACCC was heavily involved with developing a proposal to the City regarding funding requirements needing over the course of the next Franchise Agreement. The WACCC's Executive Director met often with myself to discuss elements to include in the proposal. It was presented to the City on June 29th, and will be distributed in early August to the License and Health Committee. Discussion of the proposal by the License and Health Committee is scheduled for September 7th prior to the Common Council Meeting.

The Summer Youth Media Camp was again a success this year with the EDEN Foundation participating and programs were developed regarding teen's self esteem and eating habits. Other activities at the Community Media Center included 18 people participating in training and workshops utilizing the production and editing equipment. 70 programs were produced in the second quarter and 6 new members joined the WACCC.

It is staff's recommendation that the second quarter operating funds be allocated to the WACCC.
