The major objective facing the WACCC in the third quarter was relocating their operations to the new location at 7210 W. Greenfield Avenue.

The new location had to undergo a complete remodeling to accommodate the WACCC's needs and equipment. The WACCC had to move from their current location prior to the new building's remodeling being finished. Temporary operations were setup in the Clark Building on 86th and National.

New program production was put on hold during this period of construction and moving, but staff kept the channel operational by showing repeats of past programs.

Channel Playback Coordinator Kevin Petajan is leaving the WACCC after five years. A search is on to fill this position.

The WACCC is continuing to fulfill the requirements stated in their 2003 goals and objectives. I recommend providing 3rd quarter funding for the WACCC.
