The following is a summary of reported incidents involving licensed businesses, including reported tavern violations and calls for police service during the month of June.

## **Incident reports:**

Case #13-006187, 07/12/2013, at 2208 hrs. - 6500 W. Greenfield Av. 6500 Bar and Grill.

On 07/12/2013 at 2208 hrs., Officers responded to 6500 Bar at 6500 W. Greenfield Av for a report of people smoking in the bar. Officers made contact with Scott R. Jesion, who admitted to smoking synthetic marijuana in the bar. Officers seized a package of "Scooby Snax" synthetic marijuana. Jesion was taken into custody and issued citations for smoking in a bar and possession of synthetic THC. Due to the fact no one at the bar had a valid bartending license, the bar owner, Susan Jesion, was mailed a citation for allowing an licensed person to operate a licensed premises.

Case # 13-006263, 07/15/2013, at 0155 hrs - 6833 W. National Av, Studz Pub

On 07/15/2013, at 0155 hrs., Officers responded to 6833 W. National Av, Studz Pub for a suspicious activity complaint involving a very intoxicated male harassing customers at the bar. Officer found Joel Beltran-Coyolt to be very intoxicated and uncooperative. Witnesses stated Joel tried to rip a stop sign out of the ground and was harassing customers. Witness stated she has seen Joel in the bar before and he usually gets very intoxicated and causes problems. Joel was arrested for Disorderly Conduct, booked, cited and released from the station. Bartender was Rebecca Hagmann. She stated she never actually observed the incident. Rebecca had a valid bartending license.
