Dear Council Members:

The enclosed claim has been referred to this office in accordance with Section 3.05(8) of the Revised Municipal Code. This office has examined the facts of the claim and the applicable law. Our Opinion regarding liability is as follows:

It is the recommendation of this office that the following claim be paid and placed on file:

Jeffry Jasniewski- Amount \$1,562.16

This is a claim for property damages to the claimant's vehicle on December 24th, 2008, when it was struck, while unoccupied and legally parked, by a City of West Allis snowplow performing plowing operations in front of 2133 South 88th Street, West Allis, WI. As a result of the accident, the front bumper, fender, driver's side door and mirror of the claimant's vehicle were damaged. The claimant obtained estimates for repair and filed a claim against the City on January 15th, 2009.

Our investigation of this claim indicated that the operator of the snowplow was at fault for the accident by failing to maintain proper control of his vehicle while performing snowplowing operations. The estimates for repair provided by the claimant were reasonable given the nature of the damages. Pursuant to settlement guidelines, the City Attorney's Office settled this claim in the amount stated above and obtained a Property Damage Only Release signed by the claimant.

Based upon the above, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office to place this claim on file.

PROPERTY DAMAGE ONLY RELEASE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that JEFFRY JASNIEWSKI, for and in consideration of One Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-two and 16/100 Dollars (\$1,562.16) the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby forever release, acquit and discharge the City of West Allis, Wisconsin, a municipal corporation, its departments, commissions, officials, agents and employees, his, her, its or their successors and assigns and all others directly or indirectly liable, from any and all claims and demands, actions and causes of action, damages, both known and unknown, including future developments thereof, costs, loss of service and compensation on account of, or in any way growing out of, any and all known and unknown property damage resulting or to result from an accident on or about December 24th, 2008, when a City of West Allis snowplow, while snowplowing on South 88th Street, struck a legally parked unoccupied vehicle owned by Jeffry Jasniewski in front of 2133 South 88th Street, West Allis, WI, causing damage to the front bumper, fender, mirror and driver's door of Mr. Jasniewski's vehicle.

I agree that this settlement is in full compromise of a doubtful and disputed claim both as to the question of liability and damages and that the payment is not to be construed as an admission of liability.

I agree that this is a complete release of property damage only and it is understood and agreed that it doesn't constitute a release for any bodily injury resultant from this accident as there were no bodily injuries as a result of this accident.

I further agree that this release and payment pursuant thereto is not to be construed as a waiver by or an estoppel of any party released to prosecute a claim or action against the undersigned for any damages sustained.

This Release contains the ENTIRE AGREEMENT between the parties hereto, and the terms of this Release are contractual and not a mere recital.

I HAVE READ THE FOREGOING RELEASE AND FULLY UNDERSTAND IT. I FURTHER UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO DISCUSS AND NEGOTIATE THE TERMS OF THIS RELEASE WITH THE WEST ALLIS CITY ATTORNEY AND SPECIFICALLY WAIVE SUCH OPPORTUNITY.

We were just finishing Christmas eve diner before opening family gifts. My oldest son Miguel Jasniewski, 28, was the first one away from the table. He then entered the living room and looked out the front window to see a city of West Allis ow plow / salt truck hitting my car parked directly in front of my house. The truck seemed to be stuck to my car, as my car was bouncing side to side, as he tried to get off of it.

As soon as Miguel witnessed what was going on he yelled for me to come into the living room to see what was happening. I then witnessed the last few seconds, as the truck finally broke free of my parked car. As we put our shoes and coats on, the truck seemed to stop at the next house, when we got outside the truck was speeding up the street. HIT and RUN!

We immediately pulled out my sons cell phone and called the police. When the officer, Mark Sopa, arrived at @6:30 pm he talked down to me and insinuated that the HIT and RUN was my fault because I was (legally) parked on the street, I explained to the officer that the only reason my car was on the street was that I had to go to work, 3rd shift, that night, And that if for some reason my car was in the way why didn't he blow his horn or knock on the door rather than hit the car, that is what other plows have done in the past and in fact earlier that same day!

The police tracked down the plow and sent him back to the scene. When he arrived he ran up to the officer shouting that "IF THERE WAS A FIRE EVERYBODY ON THIS BLOCK WOULD BE DEAD" the officer said "excuse me" and the plow driver shouted back "THERE ARE TOO MANY CARS PARKED ON THIS STREET, LOOK AT THEM". When asked if he knew that he hit my car he replied "I DID'NT HIT ANY THING" the officer said we have an eyewitness and the truck driver replied "OH, THEN I GUESS I DID"

HE WAS STUCK ON THE CAR FOR AT LEAST TWO MINUTES AS HE TRIED TO BREAK FREE, RIPPING THE HUB CAP OFF THE CAR...and he didn't know it! The officer then took him back to his truck to talk privately for a few (2-3) minutes and then the plow left the scene.

The officer came back to me and gave me the cities insurance information and told me to contact my insurance company for help to resolve the matter, when I did I was given two options pay my deductible of five hundred dollars, or to submit all of the information to the city of West Allis common council / city clerk. I chose option two because I don't believe I should have to spend my money to fix the damage caused by a city employee.

Now that I have the police report of the accident I want to dispute what is written, The plow driver Edwin Vis claimed there was a truck parked directly across the street from my car, that is false and an outright lie, in fact there was only one car near the scene and it was at least 2.5 car lengths ahead of mine on the opposite side of the street, that car belonged to my son.

And the officer's diagram of the accident shows the plow going northbound when in fact it was going south! If you take that diagram and eliminate the vehicle directly opposite mine and point the plow south you would have an accurate diagram.

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I do not understand why the city or employee is not accountable it was HIT and RUN he gets no ticket, no punishment, no problems and I get all the problems and run around to repair what should have never happened in the first place if the employee had used his head!

I also believe that alcohol may have been a factor, the way the truck driver was shouting and out right lied about not knowing he hit my car. When the officer took him back to his truck I thought he was going to test him or something but he just let him go, that is a disgrace!

Enclosed is a copy of the police report, and estimate of damages. I hope that this can be resolved quickly.


