Dear Mayor and Alderpersons:

This matter stems from an automobile accident on September 16th, 2004, where Carol Novak was injured. The City paid out health insurance benefits as a result of the accident and was named in this litigation due to its interest in those health benefits. The City alleged that approximately \$94,000.00 had been paid out by the City related to the accident. The matter was mediated and the City Attorney's Office negotiated a payment of \$70,000.00 in settlement of the health benefits that were paid. The matter was taken to the Administration and Finance Committee where approval was given for settlement. The case was settled and the City has received the \$70,000.00. This matter may now be closed.
