CITY OF WEST ALLIS ORDINANCE O-2022-0048

DIVISION ORDINANCE TO READJUST WARD BOUNDARIES DUE TO THE STATE REDISTRICTING OF CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS

AMENDING SECTION 1.020

WHEREAS, in redistricting congressional districts, the State of Wisconsin has established a district boundary within the City that does not coincide with the boundary of a ward established under Ord. No. O-2021-0100; and

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. 5.15(4)(a) requires that the common council shall, no later than April 10, 2022, amend the ward map to the extent required to effect the action of the State; and

WHEREAS, this division ordinance amending the ward map shall designate the polling place for any ward that is created to effect the legislative act; and

WHEREAS, within 5 days after adoption of this ordinance, the city clerk shall transmit one copy of the ordinance to the Milwaukee County clerk, accompanied by the list and map specified in Wis. Stat. 5.15(4)(a), together with a report confirming the boundaries of the City and of all wards in the City;

NOW THEREFORE, the common council of the City of West Allis do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: <u>AMENDMENT</u> "1.020 Wards" of the City Of West Allis Municipal Code is hereby *amended* as follows:

AMENDMENT

1.020 Wards

1. Pursuant to Section 5.15 of the Wisconsin Statutes and based on the published results of the 2020 Federal Decennial Census of Population, the City of West Allis is divided into twenty-five (25)27 wards. The ward boundaries are set forth and designated on the Official City of West Allis Ward Map (link).

2. The Wards established under this section consist of whole blocks to suit the convenience of the voters residing therein and are, as far as practicable, compact and observe the community interest of existing neighborhoods and other settlements, and conform with the population requirements set forth in Sec. 5.15(2)(b)2. of the Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, except to the extent new wards have been created to

accommodate legislative districts and congressional districts as required by Wis. Stat. 5.15(4). Ward boundaries are intended to be as permanent as possible.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on April 10, 2022.

SECTION 3: POLLING PLACES the following polling places are established under Wis. Stat. 5.25 for the wards created as a result of the new congressional districts:

Ward 26 is assigned to Mother of Perpetual Help, 2322 S 106th St Ward 27 is assigned to Frank Lloyd Wright Intermediate School, 9501 W Cleveland Ave
