

Shane was advised that I was conducting a tavern check. Shane was asked if he is armed security for the bar and he advised he was not. Shane was also advised to have the patrons outside to go inside as they were being loud and I did not want neighbors to complain. Shane understood and had the patrons go inside if they were being loud.

Shane had nothing further to add to his statement.

CONTACT WITH ROBERT L. ANDERSON

After speaking with Shane, I went inside the bar and spoke with the owner of the bar, Robert L. Anderson, m/w 08/28/85. Robert was advised that I was conducting a Tavern check and needed to see the business liquor license. Robert complied and

handed me the business Class B liquor license (18-00002551), which indicated that it was issued on 07/19/18 with a License Period starting on 07/01/18 and ending on 06/30/19, and expiration date of 06/30/19. Based on the fact that the liquor license indicated that it was expired, I asked him if he had renewed his license, which he stated he did. Robert stated that he did not have the new liquor license with him as the new license had not yet arrived.

Robert stated he understood and complied. I later advised Robert that he was going to get a citation for serving alcohol while his liquor license is expired.

It should be noted that as I was inside the bar, I observed that there was approximately 35 patrons inside the bar with majority of them with an alcoholic beverage.

Robert had nothing further to add to his statement.

While on scene I spoke with Frank M. Kiewit, m/w 07/17/87. Frank stated he was a bartender at Stallywood and provided me with his bartending license (19-560).

CITATION ISSUANCE



I observed William was sitting in the front passenger seat of a vehicle and appeared to be very intoxicated. I observed William had an open beer in his left hand. William also had multiple lacerations on his face and was bleeding. It also appeared Williams left eye ball may have been bleeding due to it being all red where it normally is white.

STATEMENTS OF WILLIAM

I approached William and asked him to exit the vehicle. William stated he didn't want to, and didn't need to. I advised William he had multiple lacerations and he needed medical attention. I grabbed William by his right wrist and advised him he needed to exit the vehicle. William began to stand up while PO Schweitzer and I began to escort him toward our WAPD SUV. William began to tense both of his arms up, causing officers to place him into handcuffs. I now had William sit down on the curb so him and I could speak.

William stated he had gotten beat up while at Uncle Festers. William did not know who had assaulted him, nor did he know a description of what they were wearing. William did state that the man who had assaulted him was a white male. I asked William how the lacerations to his face occurred, which he stated he "got beat up." I asked William if he was hit with any beer bottles, which he stated he believed he was hit with two beer bottles. William stated he did not want anyone arrested for assaulting him. Throughout the entire conversation with William he was very uncooperative with the investigation.

While WAFD was on scene, William was still being uncooperative. William stated multiple times he did not need to go to the hospital despite multiple officers, and West Allis Fire Fighters telling him he should. Ericka offered to take William to the hospital, which he stated he was willing to do.

STATEMENTS OF MELINDA (UNCLE FESTER'S EMPLOYEE) / SURVEILLANCE CAMERA FOOTAGE

After taking photos, I went into the business to view surveillance camera footage. While PO Vanden Boogard was operating the surveillance camera footage, I briefly spoke with Melinda, F. Rooney (F/W 10/05/74), an Uncle Fester's employee. Melinda stated she knows William personally from him coming to the bar often. Melinda stated when she arrived to the bar, she observed a white male get onto a motorcycle and leave.

At this time, PO Vanden Boogard was able to pull up the surveillance camera footage. I was able to observe William sitting at the bar near the front entrance. Standing near the front entrance, I observed a white male wearing a black baseball cap, a white t shirt, and dark shorts, speaking with another white male, who was bald, wearing a light blue shirt, and blue jeans. The male in the baseball cap seemed agitated, while the bald male seemed to by trying to calm him down.

I observed the male in the baseball cap exit the business. Through a different surveillance camera, I was able to see the male with the baseball cap standing outside near the front entrance. While William started to get up off of his bar stool , I observed him walk towards the front entrance, and exit the business. I also observed the bald male now was walking behind William and following him out of the business.

While William was standing on the porch of the business, I observed the male with the baseball cap punch William in the face 2 times with his right hand. The male in the baseball cap then dragged William off of the steps to the business by grabbing his arms. This caused William to lose his balance and hit his face on the street light pole. William was now on his hands and knees on the sidewalk. The male in the baseball cap began to kick William in the stomach with his right leg. After kicking William, the male in the baseball cap pushed William one more time causing him to end up in the street. At this time, I bystander came over and stopped the male in the baseball cap from causing more damage to William. I then observed William run east on W. Mitchell St., away from the business.

Approximately ten minutes later, I was able to observe the male in the baseball cap leave out the backdoor of the business. The time on the surveillance camera was approximately 1205 hours. DISPOSITION

Due to the male party leaving the scene prior to officers arrival and the license plate being unknown to the sports bike, there are no known suspects at this time. William declined any medical attention and was released to Erika, who stated she would be taking William to the hospital to be treated for his injuries.



NARRATIVE

At the time of this investigation I was wearing my WAPD issued body camera, which was functional and activated. The body worn camera footage was categorized as MUNICIPAL. See video recording for precise details as the following is a summary based off little or no review.

CALL FOR SERVICE

On 07/09/19 at approximately 0024 hrs, officers responded to a disorderly conduct complaint at Just J's tavern, 9033 W. National Ave., concerning an altercation inside.

Jesse explained he had been at Just J's for approximately two (2) hours, when an Asian female came in, Amara. Shortly after her arrival, an older male bar patron asked Amara about her friend's service dog, as leading up to the altercation another female patron was inside with her service dog. Amara presumably believed this patron had made a racially motivated comment to her concerning her eating dogs. Amara became agitated and Jesse attempted to calm down the situation, but Amara told him to shut up.

Amara's disruptive behavior grew increasingly disruptive and Jesse admitted he called her a "bitch." Amara, who was sitting approximately two (2) or three (3) bar stools away from Jesse, threw a drinking glass at Jesse. The glass broke, causing the facial lacerations to Jesse. Jesse stated he observed he was bleeding and dialed 911. Amara stood up and attempted to leave, as she reportedly knew the police were called, but Jesse blocked the door. Jesse explained he did not engage in any physical contact with Amara or threaten her.

Jesse stated he did not give Amara consent to throw a glass at him, causing the abrasions to his face. WAFD personnel arrived on scene, but Jesse refused any medical attention. I requested Jesse notify officers if he were to obtain medical treatment at a later time.



DISPATCH TO CALL/ARRIVAL ON SCENE



PRIOR CALL FOR SERVICE

On 05/13/19 I responded to a call at Remedy, 1309 S. 60 St., to assist with a problem between an employee and the owner of the bar. During the incident, the ex-employee, Amber R. Wilhelm, F/W 05/19/93, was in the process of being terminated by the owner, Erwin C. Magritz, M/W 09/03/51.

Near the end of the contact, Amber advised me of several liquor violations by Erwin. She said he was refilling liquor bottles at the business. He used funnels, which were located inside the kitchen. She also mentioned he was pouring rail liquor into Greygoose bottles. She said she had specifically seen him do that numerous times. See Call #19-017684 for the contact.

TAVERN CHECK

On 07/19/19, I responded to Remedy Bar (#19-1733) to follow up on the complaint by ex-employee Amber. I made contact with the on duty bartender, Dana R. Brycki, F/W 06/13/85 (# 8354). During my contact with Dana, I spoke to her about the complaint I received. She confirmed the violations were being performed by the owner, Erwin, who was currently not on scene.

I asked Dana further about it. She confirmed Erwin used funnels to refill liquor bottles. She said she had observed him do it many times, including in front of customers, behind the bar. I located several funnels inside the business, which

she confirmed Erwin uses. Two funnels were located inside the kitchen. One funnel was located by the front bar. I asked Dana if she uses funnels to make any cocktails or if she is aware of Erwin using funnels for anything. She confirmed he used it to refill liquor bottles.

Dana also advised me to check the lower cabinets at the bar. I checked one of the lower cabinets, and observed larger liquor bottles, specifically 1.75L bottles. She advised me specifically of the Crown Royal Apple. She said he's used the 1.75L bottle to pour into the smaller bottle, which is why the outside is sticky.

Inside one of the lower liquor cabinets, I observed a 1.75L bottle of Crown Royal Apple, Jack Daniel Tennessee Fire, Malibu Cocunut, Malibu Mango, and two bottles of UV Blue Rasberry Flavor. Inside another lower liquor cabinet I located a 1.75L bottle of Grey Goose. The last bottle I located was a 1.75L of Jagermeister. All bottles were partially full.

I also located the same liquor bottles in small quantities. There was a 1L of Grey Goose Vodka, a 750mL bottle of Crown Royal Apple, a 1L bottle of Malibu Coconut, a 1L bottle of Malibu Mango, and a 1L bottle of UV blue Raspberry flavored. All 1.75L liquor bottles as well as the smaller brands of the liquor bottles were ultimately seized.

CONTACT WITH ERWIN C. MAGRITZ

Erwin ultimately arrived on scene. I advised him of the complaint and asked him about the funnels inside the kitchen. He said it was to help get condiments into smaller containers. I asked him about the funnel in the front of the bar. He claimed it should've been inside the kitchen and ultimately blamed the bartender working.

Erwin denied refilling liquor bottles, but admitted he purchased some of the bottles from nearby businesses. He said he used a liquor store at S. 51 St./W. Oklahoma Ave. He also used the liquor store nearby, County Beer and Liquor, 979 S. 60 St. He also made claims that he was allowed to have three bottles purchased non-wholesale, as long as he poured straight out of the bottles. He said all the large 1.75L bottles were being used to pour straight into drinks, not to refill smaller liquor bottles. I advised him he had obviously more than three bottles.

Erwin showed me receipts of his wholesale purchases. There were receipts that appeared to be recent, within the past couple of months. There did not appear to be any non-wholesale purchases of beer. He advised me he had recent purchased alcohol bottles inside his vehicle. I advised him not to bring it in or it would be seized. He was advised he would be receiving citations for the incident.





Officer Vanden Boogard reports....

On 07/11/19 at 2324hrs, officers responded to 1414 S 65 St. for a complaint of one of the employees of Spotlite at 6426 W. Greenfield Ave. having intercourse with a male outside of the front entrance of the business. Officers spoke with Debra C. Penkert, F/W 09/09/53, and Amber V. May, F/W 12/12/89, who had witnessed the incident while walking on W. Greenfield Ave. Penkert informed officers she could not actually see what was occurring across the street, but a juvenile she was with thought that two people were having sex in front of the business. May who witnessed the incident, advised that a F/W wearing black underwear was "grinding" outside the front doors with a M/B wearing all black, and there actions were inappropriate.

Officers made contact with the bartender, Audrey Bomback, F/W 02/03/56, who advised she only had two female performers that evening. Neither females matched the witnesses description as both were F/B. However, contact was made with one of the employees, Savannah Andrade, F/B 08/10/94, who was wearing black lingerie underneath normal clothing at the time officers spoke with her. Andrade advised she had stepped into the vestibule area and smoked a cigarette while standing in the outside door threshold. However, she advised the door was mostly closed preventing her from being seen by the general public. She denied any inappropriate interactions outside of the bar. Officers did not locate a M/B inside the business matching the description provided by the witness. Bomback, and Andrade, were both advised of the complaint against the business.

The information provided by the caller about people having intercourse was provided by a third party who did not witness the incident. The actual witness stated the employee was inappropriately dancing on a patron outside while she was wearing her work attire. A tavern report was completed along with this update.

Spotlite




