Sergeant Kleinfeldt: Tavern Check, Dinger's Sports Bar - 6139 W Beloit Red

While on a traffic stop for about 15 minutes at Beloit/McGeogh, I observed two intoxicated males yelling in front of Dinger's bar which could be heard loudly a block away. One of the males in a white sweatshirt and shorts was noticeably highly intoxicated and stumbled around the neighborhood before returning to the bar, reentering, then leaving with others who were physically supporting him to get him home. Upon a tavern check, I spoke with the sole employee Rachel A Suchy (F/W 04/18/95) about this male and she claimed she did not serve him. Upon Officer Otto's request for a bartending license, Suchy said she had a Milwaukee bartending license and not a West Allis one. The owner/licensee was not there and Suchy was the only employee. I explained the problem to Suchy and offered her to call for a licensed bartender or licensee who could come work until bar close, and Suchy chose to close for the night. I encouraged her to apply for a bartending license as soon as possible through City Hall, and she stated she understood. There were about six people being served in the bar at the time. Suchy was very cooperative. A tavern report was completed.
