Dear City Clerk of West Allis,

We are writing this letter on behalf of our dog, Rylee, that has recently been deemed a "dangerous dog" by the city of West Allis. The purpose of this letter is to contest this determination, as we believe that it is inaccurate and unfair due to the fact that Rylee has never been involved in a scuffle with any other dog or human in the time that she has been a part of our family. In this isolated incident, she snuck out of the door behind Jared (holding two infants, terrible timing) who had no knowledge of her intentions. This was the only reason she unfortunately had access to a dog that is known in our neighborhood to not be very friendly. The male owner of this dog also openly admitted to Jared that his dog has been involved in numerous altercations with other dogs. His excuse was that his dog is usually pretty defenseless due to being smaller in size compared to most other dogs. If you were to ask any of our neighbors about Rylee, they would tell you that she is a very friendly dog. We strongly believe that the other dog acted in an attempt to protect its owner and that Rylee's actions were nothing but a reaction. In no way, shape, or form is there any way Rylee bit Susan intentionally, if at all. Susan did not realize she was bitten until she got back to her house and calmed down. There is no way to prove Rylee bit her, as both dogs were involved in the exchange. Rylee has NEVER shown any sort of aggression toward any dog, and ESPECIALLY never a human.

We can assure you that there is no possible way that we would allow a dangerous dog to live in our home as we have a son who will be turning one year old next month. Our friends/family would also never bring their children or their dogs to our home if she were dangerous. I wish you could have the pleasure of knowing the sweet and cuddly dog that we interact with on a daily basis.

Jared went on vacation back in February with our son and we decided to take Rylee to daycare (also a dog training facility), as she is not used to being alone all day since Jared works third shift. Attached you will find a copy of the assessment completed by one of the employees of this daycare. You will also find a picture of her report card that Katie was given after Rylee's first day of attendance. We hope you find this evidence compelling in contest to your labeling her as "dangerous." You will also find letters from various family members and friends that have interacted with Rylee in the time that she has been a part of our family attached. Finally, we have included a collage of pictures that we feel represent an accurate depiction of Rylee's true demeanor. Our intention is that you find these testimonies and pictures to be in support of our contest.

Our hearts and the hearts of so many people that know Rylee's true nature are broken by the fact that she is being unfairly labeled due to a simple mistake. We are deeply sorry for what occurred and have verbally agreed to reimburse Susan and her husband and any expenses that they have incurred as a result. We sincerely hope that you are able to take our appeal into consideration as we can assure you that "dangerous" is the last word that we or anyone else who knows Rylee would use to describe her. Hello.

We spoke on the phone yesterday about the behavior assessment your dog received prior to attending daycare. This assessment is a brief and general assessment of the dogs ability to be handled away from its owner and its comfort with meeting other dogs and in groups of dogs. This dog attended daycare through our Groupon promotion for only three days 2/6/17, 2/7/17, 2/8/17. If you are interested we can provide a reassessment, as is required when dogs return to daycare after six months, as dogs are unpredictable and behavior can vary depending on its experiences and history.

To the West Allis Clerk:

Our names are Pin and Nathan. We have known the Baroni family for over a year now. They are a great and loving family with a big heart. The family has rescued two dogs. When we first met Rylee, she was always very energetic and playful like any puppy would be. When Pin just moved in with them, she wasn't that close with Rylee yet, but she never attacked or attempted to attack her. Over time she became very cuddly and snuggly with her. As the year went by, Rylee became a very mature and calm dog. She always listened and didn't bark as much anymore as well. When the Baroni family adopted their new puppy, Ramsey; Rylee never once snapped or attacked the puppy. Even when Ramsey tried to attack Rylee in a playful manner, Rylee still did not retaliate. As for the two of us, we strongly believe that the whole situation was an accident. If almost anyone's young dog slipped out of your hands or sight, you would expect it to run to the nearest person or animal. This is a normal way of behavior for almost any dog. This is why we know it was an accident and not intentional.

Dear Mr. Cerwin:

Our law firm has been retained by Ms. Susan Kushner regarding a dog bite incident that occurred on July 17, 2017. On that date, Ms. Kushner and her dog were attacked by a pit bull terrier owned by Katie and Jared Baroni. It is my understanding that on October 30. 2017. the West Allis Administrative Appeal Review Board will be considering a "Dangerous Dog Order" regarding the pit bull terrier owned by Mr. and Mrs. Baroni.

Ms. Kushner takes no position regarding the administrative proceedings being conducted by the City. However, Ms. Kushner objects and disagrees to the statements made by Mr. and Ms. Baroni in their submission to the City (the letter is undated but was received by the City on July 25, 2017).

In their letter the Baronis suggest that the Kushner dog is known in the neighborhood "to not be very friendly." This is nonsense. The dog bite incident in question had nothing to do with the Kushner dog other than the Kushner dog also suffered from the vicious attack by the Baroni pit bull terrier. Further, the Baronis suggested that "The male owner of this dog (the Kushner dog) also openly admitted to Jared (Mr. Baroni) that his dog has been involved in numerous altercations with other dogs." This statement is simply false. First, the male owner (Mr. Kushner) made no such comments. Second, the Kushner dog has had no altercations with other dogs. It was also suggested that "Rylee has NEVER shown any sort of aggression toward any dog, and ESPECIALLY never a human." This is also false. There was at least one previous occasion that the Baroni dog (Rylee) charged after Ms. Kushner and her dog, causing Ms. Kushner to quickly pick up her dog and trip off the curb, without any injury. Fortunately at that

time, Ms. Baroni was able to stop her dog from reaching them. Mr. Baroni acknowledged that prior occasion when talking to Ms. Kushner after this altercation.

Any other statements made by the Baronis regarding the Kushners or their dog are similarly without merit.

NARRATIVE

Hartmann Reports...

INITIAL CALL

On 07/17/17 at 1600hrs, Susan L Kushner came into the station to file a dog biting report that occurred earlier today at 1100hrs in front of 8515 W McMyron St. in the City of West Allis.

CONTACT WITH SUSAN L KUSHNER (VICTIM)

I spoke with Susan L Kushner regarding this incident. Susan was identified via WI DL and resides at 1000 S 85 St. in the City of West Allis.

Susan advised earlier today at approximately 1100hrs, she was walking her dog (Schnauzer) by the address of 8515 W McMyron St. when her and her dog were attacked by a pit bull from that residence.

Susan noted that the pit-bull was able to push by the owner of the residence at the front door who appeared to be holding two small children. The pit bull was not on a leash at the time of this incident.

Susan stated the pit-bull bit her dog and violently shook it around while she tried to separate the animals. Susan stated she was so frightened at the time that she doesn't remember separating the animals but immediately left the area to attend to her injured dog.

When Susan got to her residence of 1000 S 85 St. she realized she had blood on her right calf. Upon further inspection, Susan realized she had a puncture wound to her right calf that she knows was caused by the pit bull.

Even though Susan subsequently realized she was bitten, she was so concerned for the well being of her dog that she immediately took the animal for medical attention. Susan took the animal to the St. Paul Vetrinary Clinic on 431 N 27 St. in the City of Milwaukee. Susan's dog had two puncture wounds above it's left eye, two puncture wounds to it's left leg, and a sprained right hind leg.

Susan also sought medical attention for the *puncture wound to her calf* at the Aurora Urgent Care located at 92/Loomis.

Susan advised she did not need any stiches for the wound. The wound was bandaged while I spoke with her, however, she was able to show me a photograph of the wound prior to the bandaging. Susan was advised to forward any photographs of her injuries and/or her dogs injuries so they can subsequently be attached to this report. Susan subsequently forwarded one photo of her injury and five photographs

LACK OF CONSENT

Susan stated she did not give any one permission to have their dog attack/bite her and/or her dog. I gave Susan a business card and advised her to contact me regarding any additional information regarding this incident.

OFFICER NOTES

Susan did not bring her animal into the station with her for filing this report. Officer notes that Susan's husband was with her and advised that he made contact with the owner of the pit-bull at 8515 W McMyron St. Susan's husband noted that the owner was very cooperative, advised the animal was up to date on all its vaccines and was recently checked up on at the West Allis Veterinary Clinic.

A Phoenix check of the address of 8515 W McMyron Sgt. showed no other animal complaints at this address.

CONTACT WITH JARED BARONI (DOG OWNER)

Checking the address of 8515 W McMyron St. I located a *Jared M Baroni* at the address in Phoenix. I subsequently made phone contact with Jared who advised he does reside at that address and is the owner of the female pit-bull "Rylee."

Jared further stated he was watching his child and baby sitting another child at his residence and while attempting to walk out of the residence, the pit-bull pushed pass him and "went after the other dog."

Jared advised he had to attend to putting down the two children he was holding before he could address the pit-bull. Jared approximated the two dogs being "tangled for 5-8 seconds." Jared did not observe the dog bite Susan.

Jared advised the dog had it's last veterinary check up approximately one month ago and advised the dog is up to date on all it's vaccinations. Jared advised the dog was last checked at the West Allis Veterinary Clinic.

Jared agreed to come into the station to sign Rabies Quarantine Form.

CONTACT WITH WEST ALLIS VETRINARY CLINIC

On 07/17/17 at 1645hrs I made contact with the West Allis Vetrinary Clinic located at 11504 W Greenfield Ave. I was advised that the pit-bull "Rylee" does go to the clinic. I was advised over the phone that the dog was up to date on it's rabies shots with its last shot being on 01/27/17 and not being due until the year of 2020.



Dangerous Dog Order - Katie and Jared Baroni

Dear Mr. Cerwin:

Our law firm has been retained by Ms. Susan Kushner regarding a dog bite incident that occurred on July 17, 2017. On that date, Ms. Kushner and her dog were attacked by a pit bull terrier owned by Katie and Jared Baroni. It is my understanding that on October 30. 2017. the West Allis Administrative Appeal Review Board will be considering a "Dangerous Dog Order" regarding the pit bull terrier owned by Mr. and Mrs. Baroni.

Ms. Kushner takes no position regarding the administrative proceedings being conducted by the City. However, Ms. Kushner objects and disagrees to the statements made by Mr. and Ms. Baroni in their submission to the City (the letter is undated but was received by the City on July 25, 2017).

In their letter the Baronis suggest that the Kushner dog is known in the neighborhood "to not be very friendly." This is nonsense. The dog bite incident in question had nothing to do with the Kushner dog other than the Kushner dog also suffered from the vicious attack by the Baroni pit bull terrier. Further, the Baronis suggested that "The male owner of this dog (the Kushner dog) also openly admitted to Jared (Mr. Baroni) that his dog has been involved in numerous altercations with other dogs." This statement is simply false. First, the male owner (Mr. Kushner) made no such comments. Second, the Kushner dog has had no altercations with other dogs. It was also suggested that "Rylee has NEVER shown any sort of aggression toward any dog, and ESPECIALLY never a human." This is also false. There was at least one previous occasion that the Baroni dog (Rylee) charged after Ms. Kushner and her dog, causing Ms. Kushner to quickly pick up her dog and trip off the curb, without any injury. Fortunately at that

time, Ms. Baroni was able to stop her dog from reaching them. Mr. Baroni acknowledged that prior occasion when talking to Ms. Kushner after this altercation.

Any other statements made by the Baronis regarding the Kushners or their dog are similarly without merit.
