A. CALL TO ORDER

The City of West Allis Board of Absentee Ballot Canvassers Chairperson Kris Palmer called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

B. ROLL CALL

Present 3 - Kris Palmer, Peter Daniels, and Robert Barwick

C. MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION/ACTION

The City of West Allis Board of Absentee Ballot Canvassers publicly convened to count absentee ballots for the City of West Allis that were received by the municipal clerk by 8 p.m. on Tuesday, April 5, 2022, but not counted prior to the adjournment of the board on election day (approximately 133 ballots remain uncounted). Any member of the public has the same right of access to a meeting of the municipal board of absentee ballot canvassers that the individual would have under Wis. Stat. 7.41 to observe the proceedings at a polling place. The board of absentee ballot canvassers may order the removal of any individual exercising the right to observe the proceedings if the individual disrupts the meeting.

The Board of Absentee Ballot Canvassers processed the 133 ballots; of which there were no rejected ballots and no remade ballots. The last voter number matched the DS200 at 133.

Peter Daniels moved to accept the additional 133 absentee ballots canvassed for the April 5, 2022 Spring Election, Robert Barwick seconded, motion carried.

The voted ballots were secured in the ballot bag, all required paperwork was completed and signed by the MBOABC. Hard copies of all MBOABC documents will be hand delivered to the County Clerk's office by 4PM on Friday, April 8, 2022.

D. ADJOURNMENT

Peter Daniels moved to adjourn the Board of Absentee Ballot Canvassers at 5:44 p.m., Kris Palmer seconded, motion carried.
