As you work to put together your budget for 2023, we ask that you work within the following guidelines when preparing your budget and business plan:

- 1) Include the action items from the [2022-2026 Strategic Plan](#) and Structural Deficit Workgroup ideas or alternatives into your budget and business plan as appropriate.
- 2) Maintain or decrease your total budget (payroll and operating).
- 3) Increase collaboration and reduce duplication of services with other departments.

Important Dates - Please mark your calendars

- June 27 – Budget entry instructions will be provided by Finance
- On or before August 9
 - Save your business plan to T:\Administration\2023 Budget and CIP\Department Business Plans. Your business plan should not exceed 5 pages, except for departments with multiple divisions. The template is located [here](#)

- August/September - Review of Budgets, meetings with Mayor (if needed) and additions/changes

Capital Improvement Committee Meetings

- June 5 – Capital Improvement Requests due
- August 1 (and 15 if needed) - Requests review
- August 29 – Finalize Program for Common Council consideration

Public Budget Process

- October 18 – Budget introduced to council
- October 17 and (24 if needed) – Administration and Finance Committee Budget Meetings
- November 1 – Common Council Budget Hearing
- November 15 – Common Council Budget Consideration/Adoption
