I would like to extend my deepest apologies for everything. In the past week I have made security changes. By installing 3 more cameras to get better surveillance of the 2nd floor hall and backyard. 1 camera will be directly facing the fire exit door 1 camera facing the dance floor for better viewing and 1 camera outside to get the of the backyard and fire escape. We also have put an alarm on the fire exit door that will have a siren go off behind the bar at 110 dbs. We have also acquired a GERRETT SUPER SCANNER METAL DETECTOR to wand people down before entering. We also have signage at the door stating no guns allowed. The hall upstairs is never stocked with alcohol and is a totally separate entrance from the bar. And for the past 6 years I have never had alcohol in the hall area. We will also be only allowing people we know to rent the hall and allowing no more than half the capacity of 40 people. We already have 8 cameras plus the 3 we are adding and work well with West Allis police to keep the neighborhood

safe. As far as my bartender Justin he has been in anger management and AA since the incident with his girlfriend. And they have worked thru their issues and are moving in together. We are also open to any recommendations that any of you may have to increase safety.
