NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of West Allis will conduct a meeting on Tuesday, May 2, 2023, at 7:00 P.M., or soon thereafter in the Common Council Chambers of West Allis City Hall, 7525 W. Greenfield Avenue, West Allis, Wisconsin on the: Resolution to vacate and discontinue a part of W. Maple St. west of S. 89th St. Additional project information, comments or questions or concerns can be addressed by emailing planning@westalliswi.gov or calling 414-302-8466. You may express your opinion in writing to the clerk@westalliswi.gov, prior to the meeting, or in person at the public hearing at the above date, time and location. The reason to vacate is to assemble lands for private ownership. The subject area is a small portion of right of way, of about 63x137-ft along a portion of W. Maple Street just west of S. 89 St. The property abutting the subject area is part of tax key no. 451-1535-000, 1800 S 92 ST & 9015 W MAPLE St., owned by Chr Hansen Inc. Said abutting property owner has petitioned the city to vacate right-of-way. A resolution (R-2023-0217) introducing said request was presented to the Common Council of the City of West Allis on March 21, 2023. Prior to the Council meeting scheduled on May 2, 2023, State Statutes requires publishing a class 3 notice and personal service on abutting landowners at least 30 days before a public hearing or, if they can't be personally served, the notice needs to be mailed to them at least 30 days ahead of time. Any abutting owner can object to discontinuance by filing a written objection; it would then take a 2/3 vote by the council to override that objection. Should the Council decide to vacate this portion of public right-of-way, the abutting property owners would receive an abutting portion of land. Dated this March 22, 2023. Rebecca Grill, City Clerk.
