RE: Agenda Item Request

I would like the parking restrictions to be revisited for overnight parking from 3AM to 6AM. I would like to review the purpose of these restrictions when it is not the snow season for plowing or the possibility of having a city wide even/odd policy where violators are ticketed.

I feel the permit system is cumbersome and confusing and would like an alternate solution.

Furthermore I am confused as to why permits are only available for a few days prior to the beginning of the quarter and why they are not ordered more in advance. For example I was told July 1 – September 30 permits are only available a few days before July 1<sup>st</sup>. Annual permits are no longer available which I understand, however, why can't the quarterly passes be available sooner.

Also, why can't we purchase quarterly permits on a prorated basis. If there are 90 days in a quarter and the cost is 30.00, and we buy them with 30 days left the permit would be 10.00. Why do we only buy the monthly pass?

We would like this item to be added to the agenda on the May 19<sup>th</sup> calendar.
