- Better Welcoming Signage, Landscaping and Improvement (Public Works, Development)
- Rebranding (Mayor, City Administrator, Development)
- Expand more Neighborhood Associations & Block Watch Groups (Planning Development & Police)
- Establish Welcome Wagon Program (Mayor & City Administrator)
- Increase notification radius for planning and development changes (Common Council, Planning and Development, Clerk)
