Dear Honorable Mayor Devine and Common Council Members:

The Promotions Committee of the *Downtown West Allis Business Improvement District (DWABID), would like to have two of the four tents set up on Saturday, June 3, 2017, the day prior to the 10th Annual West Allis A la Carte. (See attached map). Because of the time frame we need to work in with getting the tents set up prior to our vendors arriving we are hoping this will eliminate overcrowding during the event's set-up time.*

We have received your permission to close Greenfield Avenue, to traffic, for our event on Sunday, but are asking to close 72^{nd} street – south of Greenfield and 74^{th} street – south of Greenfield starting at 2pm, June 3^{rd} through 8pm the following day. Each location will have one A 30' X 60' tent and will remain there until the end of the event on Sunday, June 4^{th} . No tables or chairs will be set up until the Sunday, June 4^{th} . We will be requesting barricades with flashing lights to ensure visibility during the nighttime hours.

We have discussed this with Jennifer Larson, from Old National Bank, as this will affect their ATM drive-thru facility. Ms. Larson has given her permission to proceed with this time frame.
