To who it may concern, writing letter in response to findings of Summons and Complaint against Hideout Bar-Daniel Seiy. I am objecting to the recommendation of a 15 day suspension for the bar. Reasons for objections: I, Daniel Seiy, decided not to fight (or claim innocent) to the original Summons and Complaint, even though I did not entirely agree with the police report and conclusions.

I elected to not go to a full hearing because, as I announced to the Lic Committee, I chose not to renew the Hideout bar Lic in my name July 1st. Therefore, I didn't feel it necessary to burden court officials, aldermen and police officers on their off duty hours, to gather for a long hearing.

I felt the Lic Committee would take my not renewing the bar Lic in consideration in the final findings, thus not punish the bar with a shutdown with so little time left for the bar to remain open in my name. Obviously I miscalculated. It's quite simple; if I knew a shutdown (or other punishment) was still being considered, I definitely would have disputed the findings and gone to a full hearing.

Also, a bar shutdown will hurt the next person leasing the bar July 1st. The public could drive by and conclude the bar is permanently closed. That would be grossly unfair cause the shutdown would occur just before the next occupant takes over.
