RE: Replacement of Damaged Squad Car

Dear Commissioners:

On 08-05-17, one of our squads was involved in a motor vehicle accident. The vehicle was deemed a total loss by our insurance carrier, CVMIC. We were reimbursed for the actual cost of the vehicle, less our \$5000.00 deductible. We received a check in the amount of \$301.00. That check was deposited into a revenue account to reimburse the Vehicle Purchase Account #100-2101-521-70-02.

For this particular vehicle, our policy provides reimbursement of \$21,911.29 less our \$5000.00 deductible and less the \$301.00 we already received. Once we have replaced this vehicle, we will receive additional reimbursement from CVMIC for \$16,601.29. That money will be deposited into a revenue account to reimburse the Vehicle Purchase Account #100-2101-521-70-02.

The damaged squad was a 2013 Chevrolet Impala; however, we are unable to purchase a new Impala because they no longer make them. We will purchase a Ford Interceptor sedan.

(It should be noted that we will be responsible for purchasing equipment that was not damaged but will not transfer from a Chevrolet Impala to a Ford Interceptor.)

We are working with the CVMIC and our City Attorney's Office to recoup our \$5000.00 deductible from the driver responsible for the accident.

According to City of West Allis policy, the Police and Fire Commission must approve all purchases over \$10,000. We respectfully request to purchase the items outlined below.

	Description of Item	Amount of expenditure
1.	Purchase of (1) new Ford Interceptor sedan	\$25,000.00 (approx.)
2.	Equipment and Setup	\$3,000 (approx.)

Total \$28,000

We respectfully request to expend approximately \$28,000.00 from our 2017 Vehicle Purchase Account #100-2101-521-70-02. The \$16,000.00 will be reimbursed through CVMIC. Due to significant salary savings because of retirements and staffing deficits, we will utilize excess money in the salary accounts to cover the remaining \$12,000.00.

Any additional money recovered through the CVMIC and/or the City Attorney's Office would reimburse the appropriate account.
