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1.0 PURPOSE:

To describe the procedures to be followed by the Department of Building Inspections and Zening-Neighborhood Services (BINS) for filing for a building permit for new one or two-family residences dwellings.

2.0 ORGANIZATIONS AFFECTED:

This policy applies to all City of West Allis departments, boards, commissions and the general public.

3.0 POLICY:

It is the policy of the Department of Building Inspections and ZoningBINS to be governed by a uniform policy on building permits for new one_ and two-family residences dwellings.

5.0 PROCEDURES:

5.1 GENERAL POLICIES

5.1.1 A West Allis building permit application shall be submitted to BINS, The following information or plans shall be submitted with the building permit application.

5.1.1.1 Five (5) original drawings of a Plat of Survey prepared by a registered land surveyor shallmust be filed with the Building Inspection Departmentsubmitted for all new one- or two-family dwellings. Two (2) original drawings of a Plat of Survey prepared by a registered land surveyor shall be

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submitted for any addition to an existing one- or two-family dwelling. The Ssurveys must shall accurately show the dimensions and location of the proposed or existing building(s), grade elevations and the legal description of the landproperty.

- 5.1.1.2 Three (3) sets of building plans shall be filed submitted with the Building Inspections Department. One (1) set of building plans is stamped as conditionally approved and returned to the applicant to be kept on the building site during construction. One (1) set of plans is stamped as conditionally approved and kept on file in the Building Inspection with BINS office for a period of one year. One (1) set of plans is forwarded to the City Assessor.
- 5.1.3 One (1) copy of Eenergy worksheet calculations and plans for determining conformance with the State Uniform Dwelling Code's UDC energy conservation standards mustshall be submitted to the Department of Building Inspections for review and approval before the building permit can be issuedfor new one- or two-family dwellings and additions to existing UDC dwellings. Alterations to any one- or two-family dwelling which affects exterior walls or any additions to pre-UDC dwellings shall have adequate information submitted on the plans to show compliance with applicable energy codes.
- _5.1.4 _5.1.1.4 One (1) copy ofA soil erosion control plans mustshall be submitted and a permit for same issued before a building permit will be issued for new constructionfor all new one- or two-family dwellings and additions which will disturb the ground.
- 5.1.1.5 One (1) set of structural calculations and plans shall be submitted for all new one- or two-family dwellings, all additions to one- and two-family dwellings, and any alterations which affect the structural system of a dwelling or change the loading of a floor.
- 5.1.1.6 Any other or additional information required to show compliance with building codes shall be submitted.
- 5.1.2 The applicant is required to submit an online UDC permit application through the State of Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services website for all new one- and two-family dwellings.
- 5.1.35 If a driveway is requiredproposed, application for a driveway permit shall be filed by the applicant with the Engineering Department, along with required information and/or plans. The application shall include an on-

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site plan showing the locations of the proposed driveway.

- 5.1.46 BINS, in consultation with the The Engineering Department if necessary, will assign an address to theany new buildingdwelling or additional addresses to an existing dwelling if needed.
- 5.1.57 An electrical permit is shall be required for electrical work and is may only be issued enly to State and City-licensed electrical contractors.
- 5.1.68 A plumbing permit is shall be required for plumbing work and is may only be issued only to State licensed plumbing contractors.
- 5.1.79 A heating and air conditioning permit is-shall be required for HVAC work and may only be issued to the contractor, the owner or the owner's agent, as allowed per SPS 305.
