RE: Snow and Ice Fees

Dear Committee Members,

For the 2018-2019 season, the Department of Building Inspection and Neighborhood Services (BINS) will be increasing the charges for snow and ice removal as authorized in RMC 11.12(2)(c).

BINS will now charge the following:

Residential (One- or Two-Family Dwellings Only):

- \$100.00 base charge per visit
- \$1.00 per linear foot of public sidewalk that is shoveled or where ice is removed
- \$25.00 per Fire Hydrant that is shoveled

Commercial and Multi-Family Dwellings:

- \$300.00 base charge per visit
- \$1.00 per linear foot of public sidewalk that is shoveled or where ice is removed
- \$25.00 per Fire Hydrant that is shoveled

These charges are for actual snow removal. There may be additional citations or fines that may be charged to repeat offenders as found in RMC 11.12(4). If you have any questions or comments, feel free to contact me at any time.
