An Ordinance to amend Salary Ordinance No. O-2018-0027 and establishing the pay for Crossing Guards in the Miscellaneous Pay Scale.

The Common Council for the City of West Allis do ordain as follows:

PART I. Salary Ordinance No. O-2018-0027 is amended as follows.

PART II. The wage ranges (1) of the following miscellaneous employees shall be as follows:

(1) These pay rates, *excluding Crossing Guards, High School Co-Ops, College Co-Op/Interns, and wages described in (2), shall be increased by 2% for West Allis Residents.

PART IV. This ordinance shall take effect on April 1, 2019 and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
