TOPIC: Petition to exceed the alcohol license quota submitted by Satwinder Singh, for a 2019-2020 Combination Class A Liquor License for Spring West LLC, d/b/a Pantry 41 #105, located at 10537 W. Greenfield Ave.

Background Information/Rationale

Spring West LLC, d/b/a Pantry 41 #105, located at 10537 W. Greenfield Ave., Satwinder Singh, Agent, applied for a 2019-20 Combination Class A Beer and Liquor License on May 3, 2019. This would be a new non-existing location for a license. At the time there were no more licenses available under the City's quota for Combination Class A licenses. The Committee voted to move forward with a public hearing to exceed the quota pursuant to Sec. 9.01(5) of the Municipal Code.

Key Issues for Consideration

The City's quota for Class A licenses is 30. Parthenon Foods, 9131 W. Cleveland Ave., reported to the Clerk's Office that they no longer wish to renew their Class A Combination license. This brings the current number of Class A licenses to 29. Because of this, a public hearing to exceed the quota related to the request for a Class A Combination license at 10537 W. Greenfield Ave. is no longer needed. The applicant paid \$100 for the hearing.

The Committee still would need to act on the granting of the Class A Combination license at 10537 W. Greenfield Ave. Furthermore, the applicant would still need to move forward with a special use permit, which would consist of a public hearing.

Requested Action by Committee

I request that the Committee rescind the action taken on June 4, 2019 to move forward with the public hearing to exceed the quota related to the request for a Class A Combination license by Spring West LLC, d/b/a Pantry 41 #105, Satwinder Singh, Agent, located at 10537 W. Greenfield Ave., due to the public hearing no longer being required. The applicant will then be refunded the fee of \$100.
