An Ordinance to amend Salary Ordinance No. O-2019-0014 and re-establishing the previous pay range for College Co-ops/Interns in the Miscellaneous Pay Scale.

The Common Council for the City of West Allis do ordain as follows:

PART I. Salary Ordinance No. O-2019-0014 is amended as follows.

PART II. The wage ranges(1) of the following miscellaneous employees shall be as follows:

## Miscellaneous Employees

**BINS Part-Time Inspectors** \$24.51-\$29.41/Hour

Co-Facilitator (WISH) \$25.00-\$30.00/Hour (Per Contract)

College Co-ops/Interns \$12.00-\$17.50/Hour\*

Community Service Officer - Police \$11.76-\$14.71/Hour Crossing Guards \$11.00-\$13.00/Hour\*

**Election Inspectors** \$107.84/Day (2) High School Co-ops \$8.00-\$9.00/Hour\*

Lead Library Page \$10.00 - \$15.00 /Hour Library Page \$8.33- \$10.50/Hour Market Attendant \$9.80-\$14,71/Hour

Night Parker Takers \$7.84-\$9.80/Hour Part-Time Cleaner \$12.00-17.00/Hour Police Background Investigators \$24.51-\$29.41/Hour Provisional Laborers \$11.76-\$14.71/Hour

Seasonal Laborers 1st Year - \$10.00/Hour 2nd Year - \$10/50/Hour 3rd Year - \$11.00/Hour

4th Year - \$11.50/Hour Security Installers \$11.76-\$14.71/Hour

Special Voting Deputy \$9.80/Hour WISH Child Care Providers

(1) These pay rates, \*excluding Crossing Guards, High School Co-Ops, College Co-Op/Interns, and wages described in (2), shall be increased by 2% for West Allis Residents.

PART III. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

PART IV. This ordinance shall take effect on July 28, 2019 and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
