**ANTICIPATED AVAILABLE FUNDING OF \$1.4 MILLION**

Please take notice that the Department of Development is accepting the submission of requests for funding for the FY2020 Community Development Consolidated Block Grant Program. The Department expects a FY2020 Block Grant of \$1.4 million and program-generated income from the repayment of housing rehabilitation and economic development loans of \$191,000 for a total of \$1,491,000

To have a request considered for funding, it must meet one of two priorities. It must either: (1) benefit low and moderate-income persons as individuals or as a group, or; (2) aid in the elimination of slum or blighting influences. Requests must also address a priority need as designated in the Five-Year Consolidated Plan, which can be found on the Community Development Block Grant page of the City of West Allis website.
