Tavern Violation

Cpl. J. Cerqua reports: On 08/24/19, officers responded to El Sagitario, 907 S 84 St, for a complaint that Lindsey Shanklin, F/W and Austin A. Shanklin, M/W were inside causing a disturbance. Lindsey and Austin refused to leave the business when told, and were using profane language and harassing the employees and customers. They fled to their residence prior to officer arrival and refused to answer the door for police. Lindsey was mailed municipal citations for disorderly conduct, trespassing, and for underage person entering a licensed establishment. Austin was mailed municipal citations for disorderly conduct and for underage person entering a licensed establishment. Their court date is scheduled for 09/30/19, at 0830 hrs.

Tavern Checks...

On 08/16/19 from approx. 2300hrs - 0300hrs, the West Allis Police Dept. conducted tavern checks at 10 randomly selected West Allis taverns with a license to see alcohol. The checks were completed through the use of a 20 year old female who attempted to purchase alcohol with the authorization of the West Allis Police Dept. 9 out of the 10 businesses requested identification from the underage female. One business did not comply with the check. (Paulie's, 8031 W. Greenfield Ave) A citation will be issued at a later date.

Tavern compliance checks:

Tavern compliance squads check randomly selected taverns in the City of West Allis for miscellaneous tavern violations such as license violations.

Officers trained in Class B tavern compliance checks performed 33 tavern checks at randomly selected taverns in the month of August 2019.
