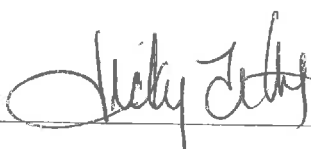

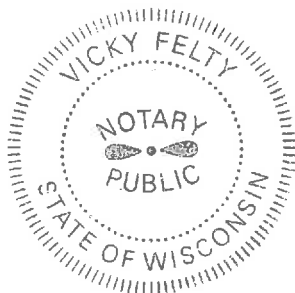

RESOLUTION NO. R-2019-0806
INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$2,500,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF WEST ALLIS FOR SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS
WHEREAS, the City needs to obtain funds for the public purpose of financing sanitary sewer improvements.
RESOLVED that the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, borrow an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000 by issuing its general obligation bonds for the public purpose of financing sanitary sewer improvements.

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$1,540,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF WEST ALLIS FOR WATER SYSTEM PROJECTS

RESOLVED that the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, borrow an amount not to exceed \$1,540,000 by issuing its general obligation bonds for the public purpose of financing water system projects.
RESOLUTION NO. R-2019-0808
INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING \$2,750,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF WEST ALLIS FOR STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS
WHEREAS, the City needs to obtain funds for the public purpose of financing street improvement projects.
RESOLVED that the City of West Allis, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, borrow an amount not to exceed \$2,750,000 by issuing its general obligation bonds for the public purpose of financing street improvement projects.
The Wisconsin Statutes (s. 67.05(7)(b)) provide that the initial resolutions need not be submitted to the electors unless within 30 days after adoption of the initial resolutions a petition is filed in the City Clerk's office requesting a referendum. This petition must be signed by electors numbering at least 10% of the votes cast for governor in the City at the last general election. A petition may be filed with respect to any one or more of the initial resolutions.

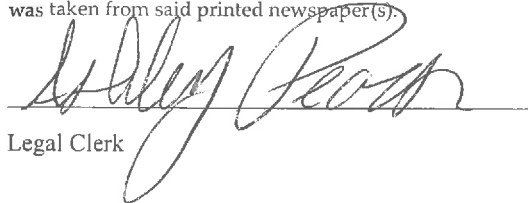

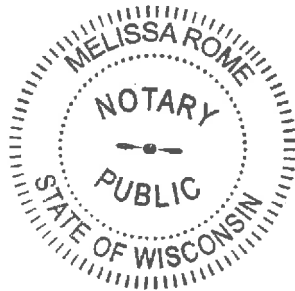

NOTICE TO CITY OF WEST ALLIS CITIZENS OF CHARTER ORDINANCE ADOPTION

The Common Council of the City of West Allis adopted the following charter ordinance which will become effective 60 days after publication. A copy of the ordinance will be maintained and available for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk, 7525 W. Greenfield, Ave., West Allis, WI, 53214.

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 25 Charter Ordinance No. 25 relating to spring primaries for spring elections

PART I. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 8.11(1), and subject to Part III of this charter ordinance, whenever the number of candidates who file nomination papers for a city office exceeds twice the number to be elected to the office, a primary to nominate candidates for the office shall be held.

PART II. The spring primary shall reduce the number of candidates to twice the number to be elected to the office in the ensuing spring election.

PART III. Not later than 3 days after the deadline for filing nomination papers, the common council may pass a resolution by a 2/3 vote of all members to not hold a specific spring primary. Upon adoption of a resolution under this paragraph, no spring primary shall occur for that spring election.

PART IV. All ordinance or parts of ordinances contravening the provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

PART V. This charter ordinance shall take effect 60 days after its passage by a 2/3 vote of the members-elect of the common council and publication, unless within such 60 days a referendum petition shall be filed as provided by Wis. Stat. § 66.0101(5), in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until submitted to a referendum and approved by a majority of electors voting thereon.

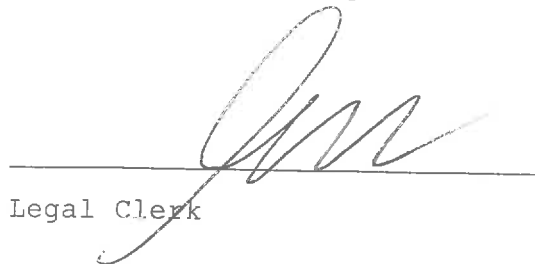

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of West Allis will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, December 17, 2019 at 7:00 PM., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Common Council Chambers of West Allis City Hall, 7525 W. Greenfield Ave., West Allis, WI.

This notice is to inform you that a Comprehensive Plan Land Use Map amendment and Rezoning request have been filed by the City of West Allis Department of Development. This notice will be posted in the local paper three times. Once at least 30 days prior to the public hearing for a requested Land Use amendment in order to meet the Comprehensive Planning, State Statutes 66.1001(4) (d), and twice prior to the public hearing as a Class 2 notice for the rezoning request in order to meet State Statutes 62.23(7) and Chapter 985.

Summary: The subject properties consist of a vacant office building property (6610 W. Greenfield Ave.), an existing Cousins restaurant property (6512 W. Greenfield Ave.) and a vacant mixed use property (6500 W. Greenfield Ave.). The properties are all currently zoned M-1, Manufacturing and the 2030 land use is identified as Commercial land use with the exception of the 6610 W. Greenfield Ave. property which is identified as industrial and office.

Planning recommends that the properties all be rezoned from M-1 to C-3, Community Commercial. A land use map amendment will be necessary for the 6610 W. Greenfield Ave. property to achieve consistency between the future land use and future commercial zoning.

This notice is to inform you of a two requests by the Department of Development as follows:

First Request: A request to amend the Future Land Use Map within the City's Comprehensive Plan (Chapter 10 Land Use) for properties, currently owned by the City of West Allis Community Development Authority, located at 6610 W. Greenfield Ave. (Tax Key No. 439-0001-032) from the existing Industrial and Office Land Use to Commercial Land Use.

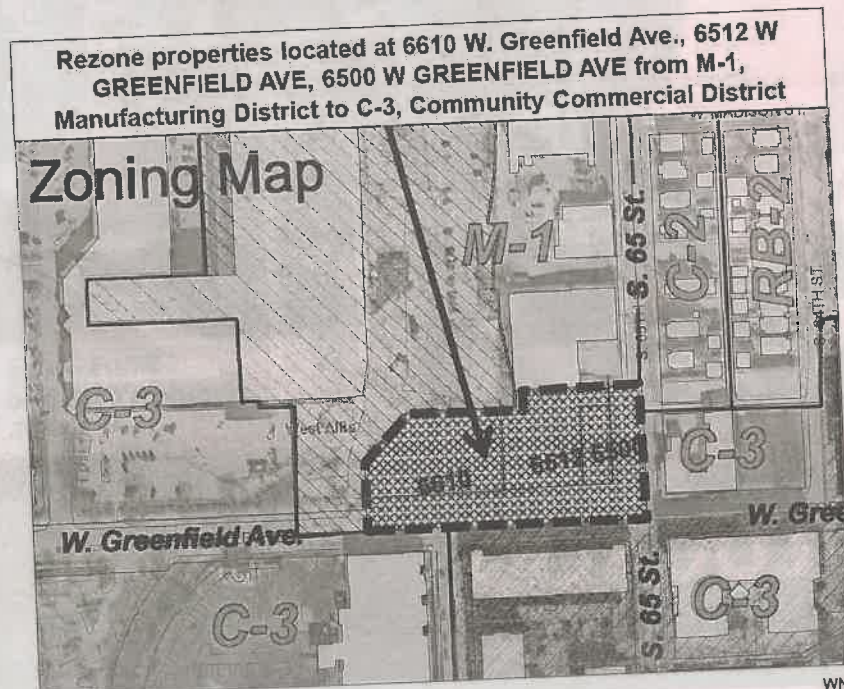
Second Request: A request for an Ordinance to amend the Official West Allis Zoning Map by rezoning properties, owned by the City of West Allis Community Development Authority, located at 6610 W. Greenfield Ave. (Tax Key No. 439-0001-032), 5 Philly Cheese Steaks, LLC, located at 6512 W. Greenfield Ave. and Jesion Revocable Living Trust, located at 6500 W. 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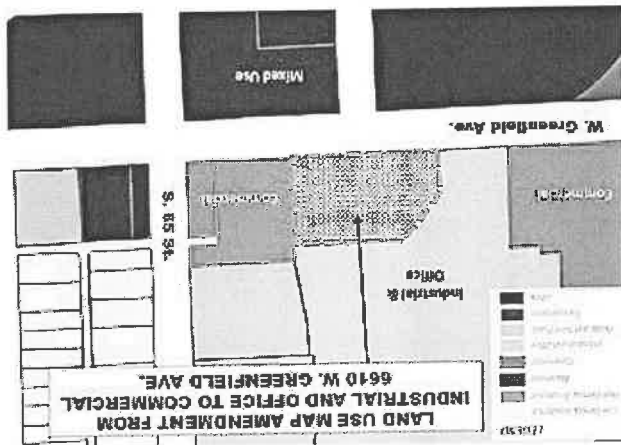
