Resolution to approve bid of Illingworth-Kilgust Mechanical, Inc. in the amount of \$244,444 to furnish and install the air-cooled chiller at the West Allis Police Department as well as authorizing a budget transfer to fund this initiative

WHEREAS, The Board of Public Works reports that it duly advertised for bids for the furnishing of certain materials and the performance of all work required for the improvements in a certain area as hereinafter described; that the bids received as shown on the attached bid report were reasonable and hereby recommends and deems it to be for the best interests of the City of West Allis that the bid of Illingworth-Kilgust Mechanical, Inc. for 2020 Project No. 2 be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the bid of Illingworth-Kilgust Mechanical, Inc. for 2020 Project No. 2 for furnishing and installing an air-cooled chiller at the West Allis Police Department and miscellaneous general construction work as required to provide a complete system for the sum of Two Hundred Forty-Four Thousand, Four Hundred Forty-Four and 00/100 dollars (\$244,444.00)

be accepted, and the proper City officers are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contractual relations with said contractor for the performance of said work, in accordance with the prices submitted in their proposal and with the specifications of the City of West Allis, and that all other bids received for same be rejected; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the Director of Public Works and the Chief of Police are directed and authorized to fund this effort by making the appropriate transfer of budgeted funds in the amount of \$124,900.00 from the 2019 Capital Improvement Program funds for Traffic Lights (LED Lenses) and \$27,995 from Police Future Upgrades account #100-2101-521.70-05 to the Building and Facilities Fund account #354-6053-523.31-02.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That approval of the bid is contingent on the City also receiving partial reimbursement from the City's insurance company as a result of the interruption to the electrical service due to a rodent causing fault within the WE Energies service line. As a result of this interrupted electrical service, power went from three phase to single phase, causing three compressors within the chiller to be damaged. The City's insurance company is currently reviewing the amount of insurance reimbursement the City will be paid.
