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**STIPULATION**

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
The West Allis City Attorney's Office, by Assistant City Attorney Nicholas Cerwin, and Boosters West LLC by its agent Keith Randolph, hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

1. That Boosters West LLC is the current holder of a 2019-2020 Combination Class B Liquor and Fermented Malt Beverage License under number 19-2209, issued by the West Allis Common Council for the license period beginning July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 for the premises located at 7731 W. Becher, West Allis, Wisconsin; and does business under the trade name Boosters West.
2. That the City of West Allis Health Department issued a an order titled, Covid-19 Public Health Plan for Suburban Milwaukee County, hereafter "Local Health Order," which in part restricted bars from allowing food or drink to be consumed on premises and required that no seating be provided to customers from May 14 through May 21<sup>st</sup>.
3. That based on investigation by the West Allis Police Department, Boosters West LLC, did operate to the extent that persons were seated inside the licensed establishment with open intoxicants on at least two occasions, specifically on May 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020, during the pendency of and in violation of the Local Health Order.
4. That sufficient grounds exist as stated above for the imposition of sanctions or penalties set forth in Wis. Stat. § 125.12(2)(b)2.
5. That based on the above information, Keith Randolph, as licensing agent for Boosters West LLC, does agree to close the establishment for two days during which time no alcoholic beverages shall be served at the premises in lieu of the City proceeding with a Summons and Complaint on the matter and referring the matter to the West Allis Common Council for a hearing on the violations. Those dates of closure will be as follows:

Day 1: Monday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020, at 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM on June 16<sup>th</sup>

Day 2: Tuesday, June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020, at 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM on June 17<sup>nd</sup>.

6. That the allegations which form the basis of this stipulation shall not be used as grounds for any future suspension, revocation, or non-renewal proceeding, except to the extent that the facts alleged in the complaint demonstrate a pattern of conduct by Boosters West LLC.
7. That the West Allis Common Council must approve this stipulation prior to it becoming effective.
8. That if the West Allis Common Council does not approve this agreement, the matter will be referred to the West Allis City Attorney's Office to take actions necessary to complete the summons and complaint process and initiate a hearing on the matter.
9. That if the West Allis Common Council approves this stipulation, the City of West Allis and Boosters West LLC are bound by the terms of this stipulation and failure to comply with said terms will result in the matter being referred to the License and Health Committee or West Allis Common Council for a hearing on the matter.
