Dear Kimberly:

Your application for a 2021-2023 Operator's License (bartender/salesclerk) in the City of West Allis has been referred to the License and Health Committee for possible denial based upon:

- 1. Conviction(s) for a felony, misdemeanor, or other offense OR
- 2. Habitual law offenses

The circumstances of the offense(s) substantially relate to the operation of a licensed premise because the conduct demonstrates irresponsible or illegal use of alcohol and/or drugs and/or noncompliance with licensing rules and regulations.

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. §111.335(4)(c)1.b. you are allowed to show competent evidence of rehabilitation and fitness to engage in the operation of a premises licensed to serve alcohol. If you choose to provide that information, the Committee will meet on Tuesday, September 7, 2021 in Room 128. Please be at City Hall by 7:00 p.m. If you fail to appear you will waive your opportunity to be heard to present your evidence of rehabilitation. As a result, your license application could be denied. Please be advised that all meetings, unless otherwise noted, are open to the public viewing and may be televised and recorded through the City's Cable Communications Division.

Please park in the parking lot on the south side of the building. Room 128 is the first room on your right when you enter the building. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
