The circumstances of the offenses) substantially relate to the operation of a licensed premise because irresponsible or illegal use of alcohol and/or drugs are an element of the offenses) and/or noncompliance with licensing rules and regulations are an element of the offenses).

As required by Wis. Stat. § $111.335(4)(c) 1 . b$., you are allowed to show evidence of rehabilitation and fitness to engage in the operation of a premises licensed to serve alcohol. If you would like to present your evidence before the License and Health Committee on Tuesday, February 25, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. in Room 128, West Allis City Hall, 7525 W. Greenfield Ave., please notify Ann Marie Neff at (414) 302-8202, aneff@westalliswi.gov, no later than 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, February $\mathbf{2 0}, \mathbf{2 0 2 0}$. If you do not request a hearing by that date and time, you will waive that opportunity. As a result, the License and Health Committee will be unable to hear your evidence and your license application could be denied.
