## Dear Sandra Hayes:

This letter is to formally notify you of the determination made by the City of West Allis Administrative Appeals Review Board (AARB) from its meeting on August 20, 2018 regarding your appeal.

At the meeting, the Board decided to waive the liability insurance. The Dangerous Dog Order was upheld and the remaining stipulations as stated on Page 2 of the Order are in effect. The owner of any dog declared dangerous, shall register it with the Police Department upon disposition, and annually thereafter on or before April 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, by providing a current color photograph of the dog and payment of a seventy-five (\$75.00) registration fee.
