AARB decided to uphold the Dangerous Dog Order with the following stipulations:

1. The insurance requirement has been waived.
2. Registration with the Police Department as stated in the Dangerous Dog Order.
3. Muzzle requirement has been waived.
4. Leash requirement has been waived while on the owner's premises; must be leashed when off premises.
5. Signage necessary as stated in the Dangerous Dog Order.
6. The appellant may request another hearing to appeal the Dangerous Dog Order after January 16, 2021, if no further incidents occurred.
