Resolution relative to extending the agreement with Ayres Associates Inc. for methane and groundwater sampling at the Lincoln Avenue landfill site for an estimated sum of \$10,100.00.

WHEREAS, in 1994, the Wisconsin DNR approved a closure plan for the former landfill site at 113th Street and Lincoln Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, following the closure of the landfill, the City of West Allis is required to conduct ongoing methane and groundwater sampling, as prescribed by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR); and,

WHEREAS, Ayres Associates Inc. has been the City's long time consultant for these services and has proposed to continue to provide the services necessary to monitor this site in 2012 for an estimated project fee of \$10,100.00, which is the same fee as 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of West Allis that the proposal dated November 29, 2011 submitted by Ayres Associates Inc. for methane gas and groundwater sampling at the Lincoln Avenue landfill for the total net sum of \$10,100.00 be and is hereby accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Purchasing/Central Services Division be and is hereby authorized to issue a purchase order for the aforesaid service and the Director of Public Works/City Engineer is authorized to sign the agreement.
