WHEREAS, The Board of Public Works reports that it duly advertised for bids for the furnishing of certain materials and the performance of all work required for the improvements in a certain area as hereinafter described; that the bids received as shown on the attached bid report were reasonable and hereby recommends and deems it to be for the best interests of the City of West Allis that the bid of Advanced Sewer and Water, Inc. for 2002 Project No. 26 be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the bid of

Advanced Sewer and Water, Inc. for 2002 Project No. 26:

Sanitary Sewer Relay in S. 56 St. from W. Rogers St. to 800' south of W. Rogers St. and S. 83 St. from W. Lapham St. to W. National Ave., Plan File Nos. S-1271 & S-1272

for the sum of One hundred fourteen thousand eight hundred seventy-eight and 25/100 (\$114,878.25)

be accepted, and the proper City officers are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contractual relations with said contractor for the performance of said work, in accordance with the prices submitted in their proposal and with the specifications of the City of West Allis, and that all other bids received for same be rejected; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That said improvements be installed with funding by Sanitary Sewer funds.
