Resolution relative to approving a sole source proposal for Public Health Consulting Services from Bay View Advanced Management, LLC for a total sum not to exceed \$15,000.

WHEREAS, The West Allis Health Department has utilized consulting services of Bay View Advanced Management, LLC for public health emergency preparedness training, drills and achieving grant objectives; and,

WHEREAS, the suburban Milwaukee County Health Departments have agreed to maintain a cross-jurisdictional Public Health Emergency Response Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the West Allis Health Department has determined that this contract is inappropriate for competitive selection due to a lack of qualified vendors and to keep our plan consistent with the suburban health departments; and.

WHEREAS, The Common Council deems it to be in the best interests of the City of West Allis that the proposal of Bay View Advanced Management, LLC be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Common Council of the City of West Allis are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Bay View Advanced Management, LLC to provide public health preparedness training; design, conduct and evaluate exercises; and develop public health response protocols and plans for an amount not to exceed \$15,000 be and is hereby accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that funding for this proposal comes from an emergency preparedness grant received by the Health Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Purchasing/Central Services Division be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the aforesaid services.
