Resolution relative to the request by the West Allis Police Department and West Allis/West Milwaukee Recreation Department to install cameras at Liberty Heights Park to enhance the Park as a safe, recreational environment for our community.

WHEREAS, it has been requested by the West Allis Police Department and West Allis/West Milwaukee Recreation Department to install cameras at Liberty Heights Park; and

WHEREAS, the IT Department will fund the purchase of cameras and other needed equipment to complete this project by transferring \$15,000 from the Safety and Productivity account to the IT Department budget; and

WHEREAS, the IT Department will fund the installation of the poles and conduit through its existing budget for an amount not to exceed \$5,000; and

WHEREAS, additionally, any and all future city projects shall consider the usage of security cameras wherever beneficial to provide additional security and safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council deems it to be in the best interest of the City of West Allis to install security cameras at Liberty Height Park and at all other future city project sites.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Common Council authorizes the IT Department to install so noted cameras referenced above and to determine the appropriate funding source(s).
