Resolution ordering preliminary plans and specifications together with a schedule of a proposed assessment for improvement of 2640 S. 99<sup>th</sup> Street by installation of a storm sewer and catch basins.

WHEREAS, It is proposed to improve the property as hereinafter described.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Common Council of the City of West Allis:

1. In the judgment of the Common Council it is necessary and in the best interests of the City and the property affected thereby that 2640 S. 99<sup>th</sup> Street be improved by installation of a storm sewer and catch basins.
2. The Common Council declares its intention to exercise its police power under Wisconsin Statutes Chapter 66, Subchapter VII, to levy a special assessment upon property for the foregoing municipal purposes. The limits of the proposed assessment district shall be generally the property abutting the property proposed to be improved.
3. The total amount assessed against this parcel in the assessment district shall be upon a reasonable basis as determined by the Common Council.
4. Assessment may be paid in full or any portion thereof, without interest, not later than 30 days following the billing date, or with applicable interest added on the next tax roll, or in five annual installments, or in ten annual installments, in accordance with Resolution No. 17095.
5. The Director of Public Works/City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare and file in the City Clerk/Treasurer's office the reports described in Section 66.0703(5) of the Wisconsin Statutes, consisting of:
  - a. Preliminary plans and specifications for said improvement;
  - b. An estimate of the entire cost of the proposed improvement;
  - c. Schedule of proposed assessment.

6. Notice shall be given and a hearing conducted by the Common Council in accordance with the provisions of Section 66.0703(7) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
