NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the bid of UPI Construction LLC for 2023 Project No. 13 for sanitary sewer spot relays, manhole repairs, and pavement restoration in:

for the sum of Ninety-Seven Thousand, Five Hundred Seventy-seven and no/100 dollars (\$97,577) be accepted, and the proper City officers are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contractual relations with said contractor for the performance of said work, in accordance with the prices submitted in their proposal and with the specifications of the City of West Allis, and that all other bids received for same be rejected; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That said improvements be installed with funding by Sanitary Sewer Funds.
