Resolution to approve bid of Rawson Contractors, Inc. for the installation of concrete curb and gutter, concrete pavement, miscellaneous walk repair, driveway replacement, sanitary sewer relay, storm sewer relay, storm sewer, water main relay, water main, building services and utility adjustments in W. Lapham St. from S. 73rd St. to S. 76 St. within the City of West Allis, in the amount of \$445,138.80.

WHEREAS, The Board of Public Works reports that it duly advertised for bids for the furnishing of certain materials and the performance of all work required for the improvements in a certain area as hereinafter described; that the bids received as shown on the attached bid report were reasonable and hereby recommends and deems it to be for the best interests of the City of West Allis that the bid of Rawson Contractors, Inc. for 2011 Project No. 8 be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the bid of Rawson Contractors, Inc. for 2011 Project No. 8 for:

installation of concrete curb and gutter, concrete pavement, miscellaneous walk repair, driveway replacement, sanitary sewer relay, storm sewer relay, storm sewer, water main relay, water main, building services and utility adjustments in:

West Lapham Street from S. 73rd Street to S. 76th Street

(PLAN FILE NOS. SP-1165, U2516, W1296)

for the sum of Four Hundred Forty-five Thousand One Hundred Thirty-eight and 80/100 dollars (\$445,138.80)

be accepted, and the proper City officers are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contractual relations with said contractor for the performance of said work, in accordance with the prices submitted in their proposal and with the specifications of the City of West Allis, and that all other bids received for same be rejected; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That said improvements be installed with funding by Sanitary Sewer Funds, Storm Water Management Funds, Water Utility Funds, Bond Funds, Clean Water Fund Program and Funds from Special Assessments.
