WHEREAS, the City of West Allis 2016 Budget includes funding for a Fleet Management Assessment/Audit; and

WHEREAS, the City's financial auditor, Schenck, provides such services and has extensive experience with governmental agencies; and

WHEREAS, Schenck has indicated a willingness to provide said services at a fair and reasonable price not to exceed \$25,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the attached agreement with Schenck for the Fleet Management Assessment be and is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Attorney be and is hereby authorized to make such nonsubstantive changes, modifications, additions and deletions to and from the various provisions of the Agreement, including any and all attachments, exhibits, addendums and amendments, as may be necessary and proper to correct inconsistencies, eliminate ambiguity and otherwise clarify and supplement said provisions to preserve and maintain the general intent thereof, and to prepare and deliver such other and further documents as

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may be reasonably necessary to complete the transactions contemplated therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the proper City officials are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City.
