Ordinance to amend subsections 12.06, 12.41, 12.42, 12.43 and 12.45 of the Revised Municipal Code relative to defining and permitting Food Pantries.

The Common Council of the City of West Allis do ordain as follows:

PART I. Subsection 12.06 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City of West Allis is hereby amended to include the following terms.

Food Pantries. An entity that distributes or facilitates the giving of goods. This use classification includes, but is not limited to, soup kitchens, and drop-off and distribution facilities for clothing and household goods.
