NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Common Council of the City of West Allis that the bid of UPI, LLC for 2016 Project No. 17 for the installation of sanitary sewer relay and sanitary sewer spot relays in:

for the sum of Five Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand, Three Hundred Eighty-Eight and 65/100 dollars (\$554,388.65)

be accepted, and the proper City officers are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contractual relations with said contractor for the performance of said work, in accordance with the prices submitted in their proposal and with the specifications of the City of West Allis, and that all other bids received for same be rejected; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That said improvements be installed with funding from Sanitary Sewer Funds.
