Resolution relative to extending the contract with N&S Towing, Inc. for providing vehicle towing and storage services for the City of West Allis.

WHEREAS, The Purchasing Division has reported that the West Allis Police Department and N&S Towing have mutually agreed to extend the current contract, at the same price and terms as the original three year contract, for a period of three additional years for providing vehicle towing and storage services for the City of West Allis, and that the proposal received as shown on the attached report (Appendix A) are reasonable; and,

WHEREAS, The Common Council deems it to be in the best interests of the City of West Allis that the contract extension of N&S Towing, Inc. be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of West Allis that the Vehicle Towing Agreement Extension dated July, 11, 2019 submitted by N&S Towing, Inc. for providing vehicle towing and storage services for the three (3) year period August 1, 2019 through July 31, 2022 in accordance with City of West Allis RFP #1320 be and is hereby accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Purchasing Division be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the aforesaid services.
